

# Year one, term one Newsletter.

Welcome to the first term of year one, we hope you had a fantastic summer holidays and that your children have come back with lots of enthusiasm for the new term. This year the year one term will include: Mrs Sinfield, Mrs Russell, Miss Wallis, Mrs Izzard and Mrs Frost.

**MORNINGS:** Please can you drop your children at the Key Stage One doors every morning. There will be a teacher here to greet the children who can then walk into class and start on their morning work. The teacher on the door will also be able to pass on any messages you have for the class teacher.

The start of the year often means new school uniform- please make sure every item that your child is bringing into school is clearly labelled with their name. Anything that has a name that is clearly visible is returned to the correct classroom as soon as it is found. The same rule applies to water bottles and lunch boxes as many children have the same.



This term we will be learning all about Ancient Egypt, a topic that is always very exciting for the children. We will be focusing on the people of Ancient Egypt and comparing them and how they lived with ourselves in modern day England.

We have weekly PE lessons and your child needs to have a full P.E. kit of white T-shirt, black shorts and suitable shoes such as plimsolls or trainers.

Please make sure you are reading every night with your child. This will really help them to make a good level of progress in the class.

In year one we will also be sending home spellings every week, please can you spend some time with your child learning these as they are so important.

In June all year one children will complete a phonics screening, we will keep you updated on how your child and is getting on and more information will follow on this throughout the year.
