Home learning

Thank you to everyone who is supporting their child with learning their weekly spellings and with home learning projects. Please also remember to help your children to learn their focus times table: little and often is best.

Uniform names and water bottles

Please check that all uniform and PE kit is clearly named. Please also ensure that your child has a water bottle in school which is named to avoid any misunderstandings between children.



Reading

Please listen to your child read every day and encourage them to read independently as much as possible. This is one of the most important ways in which you can help your children with their learning.

Remember to fill in your child's yellow reading record each time they read at home.

Please ensure that your child brings in their library book each day to school for our reading sessions.



Contact

At the start of the day, send your child straight into the classroom. Please try to say goodbye at the school entrance. Should you wish to speak with us, we will be available every day after school. However, if there is something urgent you need to let us know, please send in a note with your child or leave a message at the office.

Our PE sessions are **Monday mornings and Wednesday afternoons for both classes**. Please make sure that your child has a named PE kit in school (including plimsolls or suitable trainers). Now that the weather is getting colder, please also send in jogging bottoms.

Please leave PE kits in school for the duration of the term - they are only worn for a couple of hours each week and do not need washing every week. Obviously we will send them home to be washed if they do get grubby.
